Graceful Girl lessons are 1-1 lessons with one of our Coaches. Generally, there is a minimum of 10 practices to prepare the girls for competitions. There is a once off hall hire fee and then a cost per lesson. Costs for practices: 30 minutes - \$10, 45 minutes - \$15, 1 hour - \$20.

Parents will need to organise their daughters costume (with help from the coach) at an additional cost. You can ask for one to be made by members of our club, you can hire one through pages like: 'SA Cali
Costume Hire and Forsale' on Facebook, or our club has some on hand that can be hired out. Graceful Girls are a great way to learn ballet technique, and also grace, poise, and confidence on stage!
